OPERATOR and LEAD OPERATOR JOB POSTING

The Fall River Valley Community Services District is located in rural north-eastern Shasta County, California. The district provides water and wastewater services to a population of approximately 1,600. The District also provides park services to the residents of the entire Inter-Mountain community. The area is home to a wide variety of outdoor activities, including world-class fishing on Fall River and Hat Creek.

The District seeks a Water/Wastewater Operator, who will report to the General Manager. The successful candidate will help plan, organize, and coordinate the installation, operation, maintenance and repair of the District's water, sewer, and park facilities.

Any combination of experience and education that provides the skills required is qualifying. Certifications in both water and wastewater operations are preferred. Experience in construction is also an important factor; pipe and valve installation, SCADA management, and mechanic skills are encouraged.

The position is full time, with full health insurance benefits and retirement compensation. The District is a CalPers agency. The position will require regularly scheduled "on-call" work to monitor and respond to system emergencies; therefore, the position requires the operator to reside within 60 minutes of the District office. A grace period for residency may be negotiated with the District.
